#### **Descriptions:**

**Thursday September 15<sup>th</sup>** – 2015 IMC Design, Installation & Inspection Principles reinforces learning by supplying immediate feedback or clarification. It walks participants through the content outline of the code book, and describes key sections.

#### **Upon completion, participants will be better able to:**

- Summarize the purpose and content of each chapter contained in the 2015 IMC.
- Describe the intent and application of major sections of the 2015 IMC.
- Explain the application of the 2015 IMC through inspection, plan review and enforcement.

**Friday September 16<sup>th</sup>** - 2015 IFGC Design, Installation & Inspection Principles will provide a basis for the correct use of the code in the design, plan review, inspection, and analysis of projects. It will provide a clear understanding and correct use of the requirements identified by basic code provisions, tables and topics. Allows code users to apply the code in clear-cut situations and helps to build their understanding of the intent of the code when asked to make code compliance decisions.

#### **Upon completion, participants will be better able to:**

- Locate general topics in the 2015 IFGC.
- Locate applicable tables in the 2015 IFGC for specific situations.
- Apply code requirements to clear-cut, real world situations.
- Explain the intent behind a given code requirement.
- Use judgment to identify borderline scenarios as compliant or noncompliant
