Application Process

All scholarship applicants must:

- Submit the official application form found on the next page.
- Include a copy of your most recent student transcript. Unofficial copies are accepted.
- Must enroll in a college and plans to study the construction trades, architecture or engineering
- Provide three letters of recommendation. The letters should be mailed separately to

- Applicants are encouraged to include letters from sources outside of their high school.
- Include a brief description of your financial situation. This should include financial aid, grants, scholarships, etc., you have received.
- Include up to a two-page typewritten statement of the following:
 - Education objectives (both shortand long-term)
 - Job shadowing experience (if applicable)
 - Information concerning the applicant's construction work experiences and/or related courses to the construction industry
 - Any honors or awards received while in high school (if applicable)
 - Career goals beyond postsecondary education
 - Description of course(s), experience, or individual(s) that have influenced applicant's interest in this career field, and why or how the applicant has been influenced

Awards

Scholarship amounts can vary. Two \$1,000.00 certificates will be awarded. Depending on the applicants the awards may be combined. The awarded funds will be held until the student has graduated from high school and proof of enrollment at any trade school in North Dakota. Proof of enrollment must be provided to the NDBOA within 18 months of high school graduation or the scholarship will be forfeited.

Judging

A scholarship evaluation committee consisting of the NDBOA Executive Committee will determine recipients of scholarship awards based on information in the application packet. Applicants will be evaluated using a point system based on the items shown below.

Applications that do not contain all requested information will not be considered.

Applications will be judged on a point-based system as follows:
