Description: 2021 IRC Essentials

This class examines basic concepts of the 2021 International Residential Code. These concepts provide a basis for the correct utilization of the code. A clear understanding of the identified requirements allows the code user to apply the IRC in specific situations and helps to build an understanding of the intent of the code when asked to make a judgment on code compliance.
