#### **Description: Mass Timber & Residential Decks**

The American Wood Council (AWC) Midwest Regional Manager, Ed Lisinski, will teach the latest in wood codes in the IBC and IRC. The morning class will be on the new mass timber and Type IV construction provisions in the 2021 IBC and fire rated wood framed assemblies.
