AM: 2024 IFC: Lithium Battery Safety and Code Requirements

This 4-hour course provides an in-depth review of lithium battery technologies and the associated safety hazards addressed in the **2024 International Fire Code (IFC)**. It will examine the updated code provisions regulating the storage, use, installation, and emergency management of lithium-ion and other lithium-based batteries across a variety of occupancies. The class emphasizes practical enforcement, inspection considerations, and coordination with building and electrical codes.

PM: 2024 IFC Chapter 12: Energy Systems

This 4-hour course provides a detailed examination of **Chapter 12 – Energy Systems** of the **2024 IFC**, focusing on fire and life safety requirements for modern energy technologies. Participants will gain a working knowledge of how the IFC regulates energy generation, storage, and distribution systems in both new and existing buildings.

Friday April 10th, 2026

2024 IBC Accessibility & Usability – Commercial & Residential

This seminar focuses on the minimum requirements for new or existing construction of accessible commercial buildings and residential facilities for compliance with the **International Building Code® (IBC®)** and **ICC A117.1 Accessible and Usable Buildings and Facilities**. It addresses the design, plan review and inspection of residential buildings and facilities to ensure that people with physical impairments, visual impairments and hearing impairments can use the facilities. Attendees will participate in activities that involve questions and answers, discussion and case study, performing parts of individually and in groups.
